Abstract: The PROOF Centre team is continuing to make progress in the discovery and development of molecular signatures that diagnose or predict the occurrence of allograft rejection in heart and kidney recipients. Much has been accomplished in biomarker programs aimed that key clinical questions in the life cycle of heart, lung and kidney failure. Numerous challenges in biomarker panel distillation, assay development, health economics appraisal, health system mobilization, and commercialization are being addressed. In this seminar, I will discuss the highlights on all related fronts.
